

## **Interview task for PGCE Secondary Computing**

During your interview you will be asked to teach a 10 minute 'mini lesson' to your interviewers and any other candidates invited on the day. It should model components of a typical lesson, including clear aim and objectives, a main activity and plenary.

## You may choose to present one of the following Key Stage 3 of Key Stage 4 topics:

- 1- Key Stage 3: Algorithms and Programming
- 2- Key Stage 3: Hardware and/or software components that make up computer systems
- 3- Key Stage 4: Ethical, Legal and Environmental Impacts of Digital technology on Society

## Here are some further notes for guidance:

- 1- You will need to speak clearly and audibly.
- 2- You will have a maximum of 8 minutes for your presentation, and 2 minutes for questions from your interviewers.
- 3- MS PowerPoint will be available, although doesn't necessarily need to be used.
- 4- Please have a copy of your notes to give your interviewer.
- 5- It is a good idea to practice your mini lesson and avoid reading it directly from your notes.
